
SUMMARY: The document below summarizes a letter dated 11 November 1577 written from London by Thomas Screven to Edward Manners (1549–1587), 3rd Earl of Rutland, announcing that the marriage of Oxford's sister, Mary de Vere (d.1624), is being deferred since the Queen has not given licence, nor has Oxford entirely consented.
