SUMMARY: The document below is the fine of 18 April 1580 by which clear title to the manor of Gobions in Essex passed from Oxford to Edward Lawrence for £600. Gobions had been among Oxford's manors granted by the Queen to Leicester on 22 October 1563 for the term of Oxford's minority. Edward Lawrence may have been the son of the 16<sup>th</sup> Earl's bailiff of the manor of Gobions, John Lawrence. Proclamation of the fine was made sixteen times, beginning on 9 May 1580 and ending on 13 February 1581.

This is the final agreement made in the court of the Lady Queen at Westminster on the quindene of Easter in the year of the reigns of Elizabeth, by the grace of God Queen of England, France & Ireland, Defender of the Faith, etc. from the Conquest the twenty-second [=18 April 1580], before James Dyer, Thomas Meade & Francis Wyndham, justices, & others faithful to the Lady Queen then there present, between Edward Lawrence, gentleman, querent, and Edward, Earl of Oxenford, Great Chamberlain of England, deforciant, of the manor of Gubions alias Gobions with the appurtenances and of ten messuages, one dovecot, ten gardens, four hundred acres of arable land, one hundred acres of meadow, two hundred acres of pasture, forty acres of wood, twenty acres of furze & heath, one hundred acres of rushes, four hundred acres of marsh & one hundred shillings rent with the appurtenances in East Tilbury, West Tilbury & Mucking, and view of frankpledge with the appurtenances in East Tilbury;

Whereof a plea of covenant was summoned between them in the same court, namely that the foresaid Earl has acknowledged the foresaid manor, tenements, rents & view of frankpledge with the appurtenances to be the right of himself, Edward Lawrence, as those which the same Edward has of the gift of the foresaid Earl, and he has remised & quitclaimed them from himself & his heirs to the foresaid Edward Lawrence & his heirs forever;

And besides the same Earl has granted for himself & his heirs that they will warrant to the foresaid Edward Lawrence & his heirs the foresaid manor, tenements, rents & view of frankpledge against the foresaid Earl & his heirs forever;

And for this acknowledgement, remission, quit-claim, warrant, fine & agreement the same Edward Lawrence has given to the foresaid Earl six hundred pounds sterling.

The sixteenth proclamation on the thirteenth day of February in the same term.
