

## CLERICS AT OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE 1562-66

Edward De Vere, 17th Earl of Oxford (1550-1604), was awarded M.A. degrees at Cambridge University in 1564 and Oxford University in 1566. Clerics mentioned in the Marprelate tracts who were at Cambridge or Oxford during the years 1562-1566 include the persons listed below. There is evidence in the Marprelate tracts that Martin knew many of his opponents personally; if Oxford was Martin, this list demonstrates how he might have come to know many of them at an early age.
