

SUMMARY: The document below is a list prepared by Michael Lok (c.1532–1620x22) of the assessment, based on 20% of existing stock, levied on 19 January 1578 on investors in the Frobisher voyages for the building of a refinery at Dartford. See McDermott, James, ed., *The Third Voyage of Martin Frobisher to Baffin Island 1578* (London: Hakluyt Society, 2001), p. 17.

Oxford invested £2520 in the Frobisher voyages in 1578, losing his entire investment when the alleged ‘gold’ ore brought back from Baffin Island proved to be worthless. For documents concerning Oxford’s investment in the Frobisher voyages, see TNA SP 12/149/42, ff. 98-108. In the list below, Oxford is assessed at £180 for the building of the refinery at Dartford, indicating that his investment at that point was £900.
