SUMMARY: This schedule, which appears to date from 1587, is one of a group of documents among the papers of Sir John Popham, Queen Elizabeth's attorney-general, which relate to the scheme put forward in 1586 by which the purchasers of Oxford's lands were to repay Oxford's debt to the Oueen in the Court of Wards. The schedule indicates that the interconnected web of obligations by which Oxford had guaranteed purchasers of his lands that he would indemnify them if the Queen extended against the lands for Oxford's debt to her in the Court of Wards amounted, by 1586/7, to the staggering sum of almost £150,000. Penal bonds of this nature required a triggering event before they took effect, but once such a triggering event occurred, the whole interconnected web of penal bonds could fall due. It is known that such triggering events took place in the mid- to late-1580s. Oxford's financial situation by 1586/7 was thus disastrous. It is important to bear in mind that Oxford received no money in exchange for entering into such penal bonds, although of course he received the purchase price of the lands in question. They were merely bonds by which Oxford guaranteed that he would indemnify the purchasers of his lands if they suffered financial loss by reason of their dealings with him, the most likely event which would precipitate such financial loss being extents against the lands in question by the Queen for Oxford's debt to the Court of Wards.

Included among these penal bonds are the two statutes of £6000 apiece mentioned in TNA C 2/Eliz/T6/48 which Oxford had given to John, Lord Darcy (d.1581), and Sir William Waldegrave in 1572 as a guarantee of indemnification to them when they first guaranteed his original debt to the Court of Wards. Also included is the penal bond for £7000 which Oxford entered into in connection with his sale of one of his most valuable properties, Castle Camps, to Thomas Skinner on 16 September 1580 (see TNA C 54/1176 for further details of this sale, and BL Lansdowne 68/11, ff. 22-3, 28 for Skinner's later fraud against Oxford in connection with these bonds), as well as the penal bond entered into in connection with the sale of his mansion at London Stone to Sir Ambrose Nicholas circa 1573 (see also TNA PROB 11/60). A comparison of the names of the persons to whom Oxford acknowledged recognizances in the schedule below indicates that almost all were purchasers of his lands (see the various fines listed under TNA CP 25/2 and the recognizances themselves under TNA C 54 on this website). It is known that Oxford had entered into still other penal bonds in addition to the ones listed in the schedule below since the heading of the first set of obligations states that these are recognizances enrolled in Chancery for which no vacats had been entered, indicating that there were other bonds which had already been discharged. An example of one such recognizance which had been cancelled, and which is therefore not recorded in the schedule below, is Oxford's recognizance to his three trustees, Sir William Cordell, Thomas Bromley and Edward Hubberd, to whom he sold manors in Staffordshire, Wiltshire and Cornwall by an indenture of bargain and sale on 20 January 1575 (see SRO D615/D 45(1)).
