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Were the letters and youthful poems of Edward de Vere, 17th Earl of Oxford, written in the lexical vocabulary of Shakespeare? [Part 2 of 3]

In the following pages, the lexical vocabulary of forty-eight of Oxford's letters and memoranda, as well as his epistle to Bedingfield's *Cardanus' Comfort*, is reprinted in full.

Words not found in the twenty-volume *Oxford English Dictionary* are marked "NFD", while words not found in Shakespeare are marked "NFS". Shakespeare rare words are marked "SRW", followed by a number indicating the number of times the word occurs in Shakespeare according to Bartlett's *Concordance* and Schmidt's *Lexicon*. Proper nouns and foreign words found in Oxford's prose vocabulary have been omitted, except where the proper noun or foreign word in question has its own entry in the *Oxford English Dictionary*.
