SUMMARY: The document below is a list compiled 30 November 1578 of those, including Oxford, who had not paid all or part of the sums subscribed by them for the second and third Frobisher voyages to the Canadian Arctic in 1577-8, together with an account compiled by Michael Lok (c.1532–1620x22) of moneys received and paid out by him as Treasurer, including £585 received from Oxford.

Oxford invested £2520 in the Frobisher voyages, losing his entire investment when the 'gold' ore brought back from Baffin Island proved to be worthless. For additional documents concerning Oxford's investment in the Frobisher voyages, see TNA SP 12/149/42, ff. 98-108.
