SUMMARY: The document below is an excerpt from a record of grants made by King James which includes the grant to Oxford, his heirs & assigns, on 18 July 1603 of 'the office of keeping the park & house of Havering & Steward of the same Forest with the Bailiwick of Essex'. For further details see the copy on the patent rolls of the writ of privy seal dated 18 July 1603 by which King James restored to Oxford his rights to the keepership and stewardship of the Forest and of the King's park and houses of Havering, TNA C 66/1612, mm. 29-30.

In the original document the information regarding the grants is given in table form. However in the transcript below the six headings are listed, and the corresponding information has been transcribed in block form.

It should also be noted that in the original document under the entry for the grant to Oxford there is a note in what appears to be a contemporary hand recording Oxford's death ('d 1604 June 24').
