SUMMARY: The document below is the inventory, dated 20 May 1513, of the goods of John de Vere, $13^{\text {th }}$ Earl of Oxford (1442-1513), son of John de Vere, $12^{\text {th }}$ Earl of Oxford (1408-1462), and his wife, Elizabeth Howard. His father, the $12^{\text {th }}$ Earl, and his elder brother, Aubrey de Vere, were executed in February 1462 during the Wars of the Roses. The $13^{\text {th }}$ Earl was captain-general of the future Henry VII's army at the Battle of Bosworth, and served as high steward at his coronation. His titles and honours were restored in November 1485, and he was made a privy councilor, constable of Castle Rising and the Tower of London, high steward of the Duchy of Lancaster for south of the Trent, steward of the Forests of Essex, Admiral of England, Ireland and Acquitaine, and a Knight of the Bath and of the Garter. He died in his seventieth year at Castle Hedingham on 10 March 1513, and was buried at Colne Priory. The $13^{\text {th }}$ Earl was twice married. His first wife was Margaret Neville, sister of Richard Neville, Earl of Warwick and Salisbury, 'the Kingmaker', and daughter of Richard Neville, Earl of Salisbury (1400-1460). His second wife was Elizabeth Scrope, the daughter and co-heir of Sir Richard Scrope, (second son of Henry, $4^{\text {th }}$ Lord Scrope of Bolton), and his wife Eleanor, the daughter of Norman Washbourne. When she married the $13^{\text {th }}$ Earl, Elizabeth Scrope was the widow of William, $2^{\text {nd }}$ Viscount Beaumont. The inventory of the $13^{\text {th }}$ Earl's goods, amounting to $£ 8206$ 17s 8-3/4d, was prepared by Thomas Mercer, apparitor-general of the Archbishop of Canterbury. The modern spelling edition below has been prepared from the transcript by Sir William H. St. John Hope in 'The last testament and inventory of John de Veer, thirteenth Earl of Oxford’, Archaeologia, 66 (Oxford: Frederick Hall, 1915), pp. 276-348. For the $13^{\text {th }}$ Earl's last will and testament, see PROB 11/17, ff. 82-90. A few of the items in the inventory were inherited by the $16^{\text {th }}$ Earl and are mentioned in his will of 21 December 1552 (see BL MS Stowe Charter 633-4).
